





INSTALLATION


- 1. Clean the roof area to be covered, and wax the area with a high-quality paste wax.
- 2. Open the moonroof.
- 3. Roll up two shop towels, and insert them between the roof panel and air deflector to lower the air deflector. Take care not to damage the air deflector.



4. Locate the indentations as shown. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, clean the roof area where the protective tapes will attach.




 Install the protective tapes at the second indentations in from center of the moonroof opening. Remove the adhesive backing from the protective tape and attach one at each position. Wrap 6 mm of protective tape around the lip of the moonroof opening. 6. At the right front corner of the moonroof opening, mark with a felt-tip pen along the rise from the flange end of the opening.




- 7. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, clean the roof area and the inside edge of the moonroof opening. Starting at the mark you made, clean about 2 inches toward the front of the opening but don't wipe off the mark.
- 8. Remove the adhesive backing from one protective tape. Align the tape with the mark you made in step 6. Wrap the bottom 6 mm of the tape around the bottom lip of the moonroof opening as shown. Then wrap the tape around to the top of the roof panel.
- Repeat steps 6 thru 8 to install the protective tape on the left side of the moonroof opening.
 Remove the marks you made using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel.


10. Place the two front brackets and two side brackets into position over the protective tape and around the lip of the roof opening, and tape them into position with a piece of masking tape.




11. Set the moonroof visor on the vehicle roof and adjust its position so the holes in the visor are aligned with the front bracket holes. Install the two screws and nuts loosely onto the front brackets, and then remove the masking tape.



 Align the side bracket holes with the moonroof visor holes. Install two screws and nuts loosely onto the side brackets, and then remove the masking tape.




13. Position the moonroof visor with equal spacing on all sides. Check that the rubber seal is not twisted or rolled under the visor.



- 14. Tighten the two nuts and screws on the front of the vehicle first, then tighten the two nuts and screws on the right and left sides of the vehicle.
 - Tighten while applying pressure so that there is no gap between the roof panel and front bracket.

Front and Side brackets Tightening torque: 2 N·m (0.2 kgf·m, 1.5 lb-ft)

15. Remove the IMPORTANT INFORMATION label.



CARE OF THE MOONROOF VISOR

- To avoid damaging the surface, never use ammonia-based cleaners or solvents to clean the moonroof visor.
- Clean with a solution of mild dishwashing soap and water using a soft cloth or chamois.
- To remove fine scratches and restore the original luster, use Meguiar's Mirror Glaze plastic cleaner and polish or an equivalent high-quality plastic cleaner.
