






2 Running boards



Right bracket A




Left bracket A





TOOLS AND SUPPLIES REQUIRED


- Stubby Phillips screwdriver
- Clip remover
- Ratchet
- 10 mm and 13 mm Sockets
- Torque wrench
- Scraper

INSTALLATION

Client Information: The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by “do-it-yourselfers.”


NOTE:

- Thoroughly clean the bottom of the body between the front and rear wheels.
 - Be careful not to damage the body paint finish.
 - These instructions show the left side running board being installed; the same procedure applies to installing the right side running board.
1. Turn the steering wheel all the way counterclockwise.




2. Remove the left front splash guard (five self-tapping screws).

3. Remove the three clips and one self-tapping screw from the left side sill panel.




4. Open the front door and rear door.




5. Using a clip remover, pry out on the front clip from the back of the left side sill panel.


6. While pulling the front portion of the left side sill panel away from the body, slide the left side sill panel forward and remove it. The 11 side clips will stay in the body.




7. Remove and discard the 11 side clips from the body by turning them 45 degrees.



8. Remove the vehicle bracket (two bolts), and reinstall the two bolts.




9. Hold the new left side sill panel against the body, and fit the front clip and 11 side clips into the holes in the body, then push on the new left side sill panel until the side clips snap into place.



10. Secure the rear portion of the new left side sill panel with the self-tapping screw removed in step 3. Close both doors.


11. Install the new left front splash guard with the five self-tapping screws removed in step 1. Do not tighten the self-tapping screws yet.



12. While holding the new left front splash guard against the left front inner fender, tighten the self-tapping screws in the order shown. (The right front end cap only uses four self-tapping screws.)


13. Position the left bracket A at the installation position of the vehicle frame. Install the left bracket A on the vehicle frame with two flange bolts. Do not tighten the flange bolts yet. Make sure the flange bolts are installed in the correct positions.

NOTE: If there is undercoat on the body surface where the brackets will attach, use a scraper to remove the undercoat before installing the brackets. If necessary, clean the threads using a tap. Take care not to damage the paint finish.




14. Position the two left brackets B at the respective installation positions of the vehicle frame. Install the two left brackets B on the vehicle frame with two flange bolts for each. Do not tighten the flange bolts yet. Make sure the flange bolts are installed in the correct positions.


NOTE: If there is undercoat on the body surface where the brackets will attach, use a scraper to remove the undercoat before installing the brackets. If necessary, clean the threads using a tap. Take care not to damage the paint finish.




- Slide three square head bolts into each groove on the running board (six total per side).



- Align the six running board bolts to the holes in left brackets A and B, and install the running board with six flange nuts. Do not tighten the flange nuts yet.



- Center the running board between the front and the rear fenderwell, then torque all the flange bolts and flange nuts to 27 N·m (20 lbf·ft).



- Turn the steering wheel all the way clockwise, and repeat steps 2 thru 17 to install the running board on the right side of the vehicle.
