




Driver's all-season mat

Rear all-season mat




INSTALLATION

NOTE:

- Anchors are required to prevent the mats from sliding forward and possibly interfering with the pedals.
- When replacing the all-season mats, use the factory designed all-season mats compatible with the anchors.
- Do not place additional mats on top of the all-season mats. The additional mats may slide forward and possibly interfere with the pedals.
- Make sure to reanchor the mats after removing the all-season mats.
- Identify each mat by the mark on the back of each mat: the mat marked with "FP" is placed on the right side of the vehicle; the mat marked "FD" is placed on the left side of the vehicle.

1. Position the driver's all-season mat and passenger's all-season mat by aligning the grommets with the knobs on the anchors.



2. Turn the tabs on each anchor to secure the driver's all-season mat and passenger's all-season mat as shown.

3. Install the rear all-season floor mat in front of the rear seat.
