


## **INSTALLATION**

## NOTE:

- The anchors prevent the mats from sliding forward and possibly interfering with the pedals.
- If you remove the front mat, make sure you reanchor it when you put it back in your vehicle.
- If you replace the front mat, use a factory mat designed to be used with the anchors.
- If you use a non-factory mat in the driver's footwell, make sure it fits properly and that it can be used with the anchors.
- Do not put another mat on top of the anchored mat. An additional mat may slide forward and interfere with the pedals.
- Identify each mat by the marks on the back: the mats marked "R" or "Passenger's side" go on the right side of the vehicle; the mats marked "L" or "Driver's side" go on the left side.
- Turn the tabs of each anchor one quarter turn, and remove the driver's and passenger's vehicle floor mats.



2. Position the driver's and passenger's all-season mats by aligning the slot with their anchors.



- 3. Turn the tabs on each anchor one quarter turn to secure the driver's and passenger's all-season mats.
- 4. Position the rear all-season mats as shown.
