




Driver's side all-season floor mat

Rear all-season floor mat




## INSTALLATION

NOTE:

- Before installing the mats, identify their installation positions.
- The anchors prevent the mat from sliding forward and possibly interfering with the pedals.
- If you remove the mat, make sure you reanchor it when you put it back in your vehicle.
- If you replace the mats, use factory mats designed to be used with the anchors.
- If you use a non-factory mat in the driver's footwell, make sure it fits properly and that it can be used with the anchor.
- Do not put any additional mats on top of the anchored mat. An additional mat may slide forward and possibly interfere with the pedals.
- Identify each mat by the marks on the back: the mat marked "R" goes on the right side of the vehicle; the mat marked "L" goes on the left side.

1. Install the driver's side all-season floor mat by placing the two rings in the driver's side all-season floor mat over the two anchors on the floor carpet.



- 2. Install the passenger's side all-season floor mat by placing the ring in the passenger's side all-season floor mat over one anchor on the floor carpet.
- 3. Install the rear all-season floor mat by placing the two rings in the rear all-season floor mat over the two anchors on the floor carpet.
